

## Decision on the introduction of necessary epidemiological measures for the area of Split-Dalmatia County

Upon proposal of the Civil Protection Headquarters of the Split-Dalmatia County, the necessary epidemiological measures for the area of the Split-Dalmatia County are being introduced.

Necessary measures from this Decision are as follows:

- Obligatory wearing of face masks or medicine masks on open spaces where greater flow of people is expected ( open markets, spaces around shopping centres, religious objects and sim,) regardless the physical distance
- Ban on the sale of alcoholic beverages in the period between 8,00 p.m. and 6,00 a.m.
- Restricting the operation of rural facilities and family farms providing catering services in such a way that food, drinks, beverages and sweets can be served on open terraces or other open service areas only, in strict compliance with the prescribed epidemiological measures and special recommendations and instructions of the Croatian Institute of Public Health, and working hours can be determined from 6,00 a.m. to 8,00 p.m.
- opening hours of casinos, slot machine clubs and payment points for betting can be determined from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., with a ban on providing catering services in their premises
- suspension of children's playrooms and holding children's workshops indoors
- Foreign language schools may teach only online or otherwise to maintain distance contacts
- recommendation to social care institutions that provide accommodation services to suspend visits to beneficiaries indoors
- recommendations to social welfare institutions that provide accommodation services to organize the visits of beneficiaries, wherever possible, in the open in strict compliance with all prescribed epidemiological measures and special recommendations and instructions adopted of the Croatian Institute of Public Health.

The staffs of local self-government units are in charge of intensified supervision of compliance with prescribed epidemiological measures, and especially necessary epidemiological measures related to public events and gatherings, private gatherings, public transport and the operation of shopping centres and restaurants.

These measures enter into force on April 1, 2021, and last until April 15, 2021.
